

DESIGNING A BULLETIN BOARD DISPLAY

I will provide you with a piece of poster board which will represent a classroom bulletin board. Using the piece of poster board, do the following:

1. Select a Driver Education "theme" – some examples:
 - Accidents (various types: car/truck; car/car; car/jogger-bicyclist-pedestrian; car/object – tree-house-store-pole)
 - Basic Maneuvers (Parking, Right / Left Turns, Turnabouts)
 - Buying a Car (New or Used)
 - Car maintenance (oil changes, tire rotation, routine checkups)
 - Distractions (cell phone, eating, kids)
 - Drinking and Driving
 - Emergencies (brake failure, steering failure, flat tire)
 - Insurance
 - Motorcycles
 - New Car Models / Used Car Models
 - Physical Condition of the Driver
 - Railroad Crossings
 - Road Rage
 - Traffic Signs and Signals
 - Your Choice – Get Instructor Approval**

2. Using your selected theme, create a bulletin board display that you could put on an actual bulletin board (full size) in your classroom.

3. Use whatever materials you can to properly display-illustrate-represent your theme:
 - Magazine/Newspaper articles / pictures
 - Computer generated items
 - Pamphlets
 - Brochures
 - Advertisements
 - Ellison Letters (available in most school libraries)
 - Paste/glue/stick on letters-numbers, etc.

4. Grading will be based upon
 - Originality
 - Creativity
 - Correct spelling of words used on the display
 - Use of Space (cover entire piece of poster board)
 - Use of Materials
 - Variety of Materials
 - Proper relationship between the materials and the chosen theme.**
